



AECOM-led team one of 11 contractors awarded US\$907-million environmental-management-services contract for U.S. Department of Energy sites nationwide

The AECOM-led team, one of 11 contractors selected, may provide environmental remediation, deactivation, decommissioning, demolition, contamination removal, and regulatory services at various locations throughout the U.S. in support of the DOE, including the National Nuclear Security Administration. The contracts have a ceiling of US\$907 million with a five-year performance period.
