"Welcoming Tecsalt to the AECOM family will provide both firms with outstanding global growth opportunities," said John M. Dionisio, AECOM president and chief executive officer. "AECOM is expanding its energy practice - particularly in hydropower - and we are expanding the broad portfolio of expert services that we can deliver to our clients around the world."

Founded in 1961, Tecsalt has completed projects in more than 80 countries on five continents.

"We are excited about the opportunities on the horizon for our employees and our clients as part of the AECOM team. We are very proud to become AECOM's global center of excellence in hydropower and dams, and to be taking a leadership role in AECOM's international development program," said Luc Benoit, Tecsalt president and chief executive officer. Benoit will take on a greater role in the combined organization and will also join AECOM's Leadership Council.

The acquisition has been approved by Tecsalt shareholders and is subject to customary closing conditions, including necessary regulatory approvals.
