



AECOM wins \$15-million contract from N.J. Department of Transportation

Company to provide construction-management and inspection services to upgrade Route 52 in southern New Jersey

LOS ANGELES--(BUSINESS WIRE)--Jul. 8, 2009-- AECOM Technology Corporation (NYSE: ACM), a leading provider of professional technical and management support services for government and commercial clients around the world, announced today that it has won a \$15-million roadway contract from the N.J. Department of Transportation (NJDOT).

AECOM will provide construction-management and inspection services to complete the second phase of the replacement of causeway bridges and roadway sections of Route 52 in the southern part of the state. The \$250-million project will eliminate two drawbridges at the Ocean City and Somers Point limits and eliminate Somers Point Circle, with improvements to MacArthur Boulevard.

The state will use approximately \$70 million of federal stimulus money on the project.

"We are proud to be selected for this important roadway project to improve the quality of life in this vital part of the Jersey Shore," said John M. Dionisio, AECOM president and chief executive officer. "Transportation investments like this positively impact the economy by fueling job creation and reflect the NJDOT's commitment to maintain and improve our infrastructure needs."

The project is slated for completion during 2012.
